- Fine in the amount of 2500 RON paid to the organizer;

The crews participating in both CNRB and CNRB / Tarmac will pay the CNRB entry fee + 500 RON CNRB / Tarmac fee.

Any entry form received after the closing date for entries, Monday, 07 June 2021, at 16:00 will be accepted with the increased payment of the entry fee by 50%.

5. Insurances

The insurance fee included in the registration fee guarantees competitors coverage for any civil damages against third parties. The competitors will be insured against third parties in the amount of 100,000 RON.

This insurance will include all people within the rally organization (especially Officials) and co-drivers (on all Special Stages), accredited journalists / photographers and drivers with a foreign drivers's license, demanding that there is no other casualty insurance concluded by a local or foreign insurance company.

Legal liability insurance is compulsory for all cars participating at the rally. This has to be contracted by the owner of the car. The legal liability insurance has to cover all damages on all routes excepting the Special Stages and the Shakedown. The existence of this legal liability insurance has to be proved at the administrative check.

Service, reconnaissance and auxiliary cars are excluded from this organization liability cover insurance. In case of any accident with only material and no human damages, the competitor has the absolute obligation to report such damages immediately at the following Time Control Point. A detailed written report at the end of the Leg must be filled in at the Rally HQ.

Furthermore, in case of physical damage, the driver must immediately inform the Rally HQ.



6. Advertising and Identification

See Supplementary Regulations appendix Decals and supplementary advertising.

6.1. Organizer mandatory advertising

” RALIUL ARGEŞULUI CATENA 2021”

The organizer will provide each crew with an identification sticker (45 x 15cm), which must be applied to the car in the position provided before the initial technical checks. Each panel will be placed horizontally starting with the leading edge of each front door, with the number located towards the front. The upper edge of this panel should be located at a distance of 7 to 10 cm from the lower limit of the glass. **It is not allowed to cut this panel.**

6.1.1 Optional Organiser’s advertisement

The organizer will provide each crew that has accepted the display of the optional advertising: 2 panels of 30 cm x 20 cm, which will be placed according to APPENDIX IV: COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING.

6.2. FRAS mandatory advertising

According CNRB 2021 Regulations.

6.3. Advertising for CATENA Arges Rally 2021 participating crew partners

All crews registered for the Catena Arges Rally 2021 will be able to organize sports advertising activities (tents, branding, sampling, hostess, autograph sessions, etc.) only in the area allocated within the service park.

Rally locations: start / finish area, awards ceremony, press conference room, VIP area, superspecial test start are exclusive locations for the organizer's partners. Crews may organize sports advertising activities in these areas only with the written consent of the organizer (by contract). Otherwise, the organizer will sanction the crew with a fine of 2500 Lei.

The promotion of the crew partner in the form of commercial advertising (direct promotion of product, services, offers) without the written consent of the organizer (by contract), is interpreted as prohibited advertising and will be sanctioned by the organizer with a fine of 5000 Lei.

7. Tyres

7.1. Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

7.2. Tyres for use at reconnaissance

No restrictions.

7.3. Special Requirements

It is allowed to modify the footprint of the tyres (hand-cutting), complying with the manufacturer's given specifications.

All competitors, mechanics and the present STAFF are obliged to comply with the restrictions imposed by the organizer regarding the prevention of the spread of COVID-19. The sanction will be a fine, or exclusion from the event.

The competitors are required to offer a short interview in the Stage STOP, Technical Zones or Regroups.



8. Fuel

9. Reconnaissance

9.1 General

Reconnaissance will be according to 2021 CNRB Regulations - Art. 35. The reconnaissance schedule is published in Supplementary Regulations Art.3. The reconnaissance will not be monitored by marshals at the start and stop of Special Stages.

Competitors are required to use the GPS system. Competitors are solely responsible for starting and operating the GPS system. Failure to comply with the provisions of this aligned is sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course as follows: the first offense with a fine of 250 RON, the second offense with a fine of 1250 RON, the third offense with the refusal to start.

Any involvement of a crew in a road event or accident during reconnaissance will be reported immediately to the official Competitor's Relations Officer or to the emergency phone and may be sanctioned by the Clerk of the Course with a fine, exclusion or proposal to suspend the license.

9.2 Entry procedure

All documents will be received by e-mail at the mailing address in the application form. Reconnaissance cars must be registered in a separate form. This form will be sent to the organizer, online, at the latest until the entry on the first special test. Each car must be identified with a number of reconnaissance provided by the organizer. Cars used in the rally cannot be used for reconnaissance. Reconnaissance numbers to be fixed on the right side - front of the windshield and on the rear window. It is not allowed to detach these numbers during reconnaissance. Competitors are required to immediately notify the secretariat of the competition in case of change of the reconnaissance car. In this case another form with the new data must be sent. Specific last minute rules will be published in a bulletin.



9.3 Specific regulations

9.3.1 During reconnaissance, all national traffic rules must be followed, including but not limited to speed limits. Please note that Special Stages will not be closed to traffic during reconnaissance.

9.3.2 The maximum speed allowed for the reconnaissance of special stages is according to the Romanian Road Code (for National Roads and County Roads the speed limit is 90 km / h; a tolerance of 10 km / h is allowed), except in cases in which speed restrictions are imposed on the road. These restrictions determine the maximum speed allowed. Additional limitations may be marked in the Road Book.

9.3.3 Exceeding the speed limit during the reconnaissance for the special stages and for Shakedown will lead to the application of a fine by the Clerk of the Course as follows: 50 Lei for each kilometer per hour above the speed limit. The fine applies when the speeding has been for more than 10 seconds (in the case of GPS system measurements). Fines are paid to FRAS until the first Stewards meeting, under the sanction of refusal to start.

9.3.4 Any other violation of the provisions of the Traffic Code during the reconnaissances will attract a penalty from the Sports Commissioners, according to CNRB Regulation - Art. 34.3.4.

9.3.5 The amount of the fines will not change in the case of any other fine imposed by the police. The amount of the fine will be doubled if the offense is repeated during the same rally.

9.3.6 In the event of a breach of traffic law committed by a crew participating in the rally, the police officers or officers who found the breach must inform the offender accordingly, in the same way as for road users. ordinary.

9.3.7 If the police or officials decide not to stop the offender, they may request the application of the sanctions provided for in the legislation, provided that: The notification of the offense is received officially and in writing before the publication of the provisional ranking. The minutes shall be sufficiently detailed so that the identity of the offending pilot is indisputably established, with the exact specification of the place and time at which the offense took place.

The facts alleged not to be susceptible to interpretation.

9.3.8 It is strictly forbidden to return on the special stages, with the exception of SS1 / SS3!



9.4 Collection of speed control checking devices (GPS)

9.4.1 All reconnaissance vehicles must be equipped with a speed tracking device. These devices will be collected according to the Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronological order and locations). Depending on where they want to start the reconnaissance, the crews can request in the entry form the location where they will pick-up the GPS device (Câmpulung and Piteşti).

9.4.2 The fee for the GPS device is included in the registration fee and is of 250 Lei for CNRB, CNRB / Asphalt, CNRVIB crew and 200 Lei for CNR2B.

10. Administrative checks

10.1 Documents to be submitted:

In order to carry out the online administrative checks, the administrative checks form will be sent to the e-mail address of the organizer, which will include:

- Driver and co-driver license
- Driver / co-driver ID cards / passports
- Valid driving licenses (or valid replacement evidence) for driver and co-driver
- ASN authorization for foreign competitors (if required)
- Application form completed in full
- Car documents
- Declaration with the consent of the owner of the car for its use
- Periodic Technical Inspection of the car
- Mandatory Insurance

10.2 Program

According to the program in chronological order (Art. 3 of the Supplementary Regulations).

11. Initial scrutineering, sealing and marking

11.1 Initial scrutineering, location and program

According to Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronological order and locations). A detailed schedule will be published separately according to the Supplementary Regulations - Art. 3 (Schedule in chronological order and locations). The cars can be presented at the initial scrutineering by a team representative.



CNR2B crews wishing Shakedown will make initial scrutineering Thursday, 10 June 2021, between 17:00 – 19:15. The CNR2B crews unwilling to participate in the shakedown will have initial scrutineering Friday, 11 June 2021, 08:00 – 09:00 at the stand of each crew in the service park

At the initial scrutineering, the GPS monitoring system for the competition cars will be verified.

11.2 Mandatory documents

- Approval form;
- SOS / OK panels in A3 format;
- FRAS technical passport.

11.3 Windows

According to CSI - Annex J - Article 253.11.

11.4 Protective equipment for competitors

The equipment must comply with the International Sporting Code – Appendix L - Chap. III. The equipment will be checked during the rally. It will not be necessary to present the equipment at the initial scrutineering.

11.5 Noise level

According to the CNRB Regulation 2021.

11.6 Special national provisions

All epidemiological prevention measures must be followed by all participants.

11.7 Installing the GPS monitoring system

The GPS monitoring system must be located on all cars. Each crew must install the system before the initial scrutineering, according to the instructions received from the GPS representative.

The unmounting of the GPS system for One Event licensed crews will be performed in the technical zone before the last entry into the service park by the GPS representative.



Both One Event crews and annual licensed crews must return the GPS device to the HQ no later than Saturday, 12 June 2021, at 18:00. Loss, non-delivery or damage to the equipment will result in a fine of 2500 Lei, paid to FRAS.

12. Other procedures

12.1 Procedures and festive start order

The festive start is mandatory for all CNRB, CNRB / Asphalt, CNRVIB crews and optional for CNR2B crews. The order for the festive start will be announced. The celebration of the festive start will be announced through a bulletin issued later.

12.2 Festive Finish

The festive finish of the stage will consist in awarding the first three crews from the FIA General Classification and the first three crews from the OPEN Classification. The festivity area will be located after the last special stage.

During the festive Finish, the anti-COVID-19 health protocol must be followed: wearing a protective mask and keeping social distance.

12.3 Advance entry and handing in / changing timecards

12.3.1 The competitors can check in in advance without penalty in the following time controls: TC 4C, TC 4D, TC 8C, TC 8D.

12.3.2 The timecards will be handed/changed in the following time controls: CO 0, TC 2B, TC 4D, TC 4E, TC 6B, TC 8D.

12.4 Shakedown:

12.4.1 Participants:

Only crews who have passed the administrative checks and the initial scrutineering are allowed. Participation is possible only in compliance with all the rules provided for special tests (publicity and complete identification, all approved clothing, etc.).

A maximum of 5 passages will be allowed.

12.4.2 Location and Date:

Shakedown Service Parc: there will be no specific service park.

12.4.3 Guests

Anyone (except the driver and co-driver) wishing to participate in Shakedown must sign a declaration on their own responsibility (Appendix 6 to the Supplementary Regulations) and complete the Covid-19 Questionnaire. This statement and questionnaire, together with a copy of passport or identity card must be sent by e-mail inscrieri@raliulargesului.ro by Thursday, 10 June 2021, at 20:00.

12.5 Special procedures for the service park:

12.5.1 Location: Piteşti, Piaţa Vasile Milea nr.1

12.5.2 Service Park Responsible:

Will be announced.

12.5.3 Allocation of service space

In the main service park, an area of at least 42 m² (6 x 7 m) will be provided by the organizer for each crew. The allocation of additional space is made according to the available space and is charged with 25 Lei / m². The organizer reserves the right to check and measure the space provided by it. The detection by the organizer of exceeding the allocated space will be charged with 125 Lei / m².

The placement of the crews in the service park will be done according to a displayed plan published on the Digital Display Panel and following the instructions of the organizer.

It is forbidden to park the platforms inside the service park or in any other location that could confuse traffic in the area. The organizer may propose to the Clerk of the Course the sanctioning of crews who do not comply with this rule.

The platforms must be parked in the following location: It will be nominated

12.5.4 Speed Limit

According to Art. 57.4 from the CNRB regulations.

12.5.5 Behavior

- Access to the Service Park is allowed only for competition cars and for technical vehicles identified by the “Service” and / or “Auxiliary” badges distributed by FRAS when the licenses are issued.
- Damage to the surface of the service park must be avoided. It is forbidden to fix tents in nails, screws or other materials that can damage the surface. The crew is responsible for any damage to the asphalt surface in the assigned area.



- Under each competition car, a waterproof and hydrocarbon-resistant foil must be placed on a sufficiently large surface at all times during service operations.
 - Service operations will not lead to permanent and avoidable damage.
 - Power is only allowed in the area provided for power.
 - Absurd or intentional behavior against environmental protection is particularly damaging to the image of motorsport and will be punished, even if there are no specific regulations.
 - After the rally, the service park must be handed over in its original condition. Crews are responsible for removing waste and used fluids.
- Any violation of these rules leads to a fine of 500 Lei paid to the organizer until Saturday, 12 June 2021, at 20:00.

12.6 Power Stage

Power Stage is SS 8 Lacul Vidraru and for CNR2B - SS 4 Lacul Vidraru.

12.7 Special national procedures

12.7.1 Availability of participants

Competitors who entered their cars in Parc Fermé at the end of the rally must remain available on the phone (mobile) until the final results are displayed.

12.7.2 Classifications

The official final rankings will not be distributed after the event. Final results will be published on the rally website on the digital display panel www.raliulargesului.ro.

12.7.3 Remote Service Area (tires & lights):

According to Art. 60 from CNRB regulations.

12.7.4 Tyre Fitting Zone (TFZ)

A tyre fitting zone will be placed after the Regroup A Câmpulung (marked in the itinerary between TC2B and TC2C).

According to the CNRB 2021 regulations art. 60.5, at each tyre fitting zone:

- No work is allowed within the marked zone other than for the crew alone to change the wheels, and only using equipment carried on board the competing car. An extra car jack may be brought by a team member;
- The extra tyres to be used may, however, be transported to the zone in a service car and be prepared by team members to be fitted to the rally car.



- One team member may be present in the zone for the changing of tyres and as allowed by Art. 13.8 in CNRB regulations.
- It is mandatory for all cars to pass through the tyre fitting zone and to stop at the tyre marking zone even if wheels are not changed.
- A wheel / tyre marking and barcode reading zone at which each car must stop will be established at the exit of each tyre fitting zone.
- The tyres will be brought/transported by the mechanics of each crew.

12.8 Start System in Special Stages

At the start of each special stage a clock with a digital LED display will be showing the hour, minute, second and two arrays of green and red LEDs. The display will be connected to a GPS / GSM equipment, with satellite connection, to synchronize all time equipment on the special stages.

12.9 Official time: Romania's GPS time.

12.10 Start list and interval:

12.10.1 Day 1:

- FIA & FRAS priorities in the order of the general ranking;
- The other drivers, in the order of the ranking of the performance coefficient on the special stages;
- CNRVI drivers in the order of ranking the performance coefficient on special stages;
- Rally2 drivers in order of performance coefficient ranking on special stages;
- Drivers who are not found in the FRAS rankings / performance rankings on special stages will be positioned by the Clerk of the Course.

12.10.2 Day 2:

- The pilots registered in CNRB according to the ranking of the first day
- CNRVIB pilots according to the ranking of the first leg;
- CNR2B pilots according to the ranking of the first leg.
- The start time for CNR2B on day II is indicative and depends on the number of CNRB + CNRVIB crews taking the start.

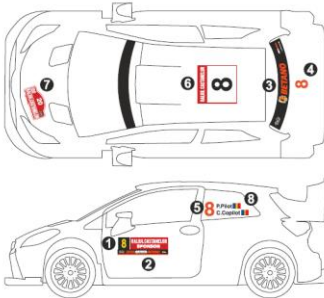

APPENDIX IV: COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING



1) Two front door panels measuring 67 cm wide by 17 cm high including a 1 cm white surround. Each of these panels shall comprise a matt black competition number box which shall always be at the front of the panel. Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803), 14 cm high. The remainder of this door panel is reserved for the organiser.

2) Below these panels will be placed a rectangle 67 cm long and 5 cm wide, with the name of the championship. A sticker provided by FRAS is compulsory for all the starting

crews. Its location cannot be changed.

3) One rear window panel measuring a maximum of 90 cm wide and 10 cm high shall be positioned at the top in the centre of the rear window.

4) An adjacent area of 15 cm x 15 cm shall contain a fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the rear at eye level.

5) Two numbers for each rear side window which shall be 20 cm high, coloured fluorescent orange (PMS 804), and may be reflective. These numbers shall be placed on the rear side windows adjacent to the crew's name.

6) One roof panel, 50 cm wide by 52 cm high, to be placed on the roof with the top towards the front of the car. A matt black competition number, 28 cm high, will be displayed on a matt white background 50 cm wide by 38 cm high.

7) One plate fitting into a rectangle 43 cm wide by 21.5 cm high which shall include at least the competition number and full name of the rally.

8) The first initial(s) and surname of the driver and the co-driver, as well as the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their licences, must appear on the rear side window on both sides of the car, adjacent to the competition number.

The names must be: • In white Helvetica. • In upper case for the initial(s) and first letter of each name with the remainder in lower case. • 6 cm high and with a stroke width of 1.0 cm.

The driver's name shall be the upper name on both sides of the car.

APPENDIX V: EXTRACTS FROM FIA ISC - APPENDIX L

All competitors are reminded of FIA ISC - Appendix L, in particular its Chapter III - Driver's Equipment.

Helmets (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858 - 2002 or 8858 - 2010 (Technical List No. 41);
- 8859 - 2015 (Technical List No. 49);
- 8860 - 2004 or 8860 - 2010 (Technical List No. 33);
- 8860 - 2018 or 8860 - 2018 - ABP (Technical List No. 69).

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List No. 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List No. 27) or 8856 - 2018 (Technical List No. 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates, etc.) **as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements!**

See also FIA-RRSR - Art. 53.1.

Biometric Devices (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during the rally. • If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 or 8868 - 2018.

- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868 - 2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (FIA ISC - Appendix L, Ch. III, Art. 5)



The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing of metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.
